PREFIXES

- Letters placed in front of a word that changes its meaning.

SUFFIXES

- Letters placed at the end of a word that changes its meaning.

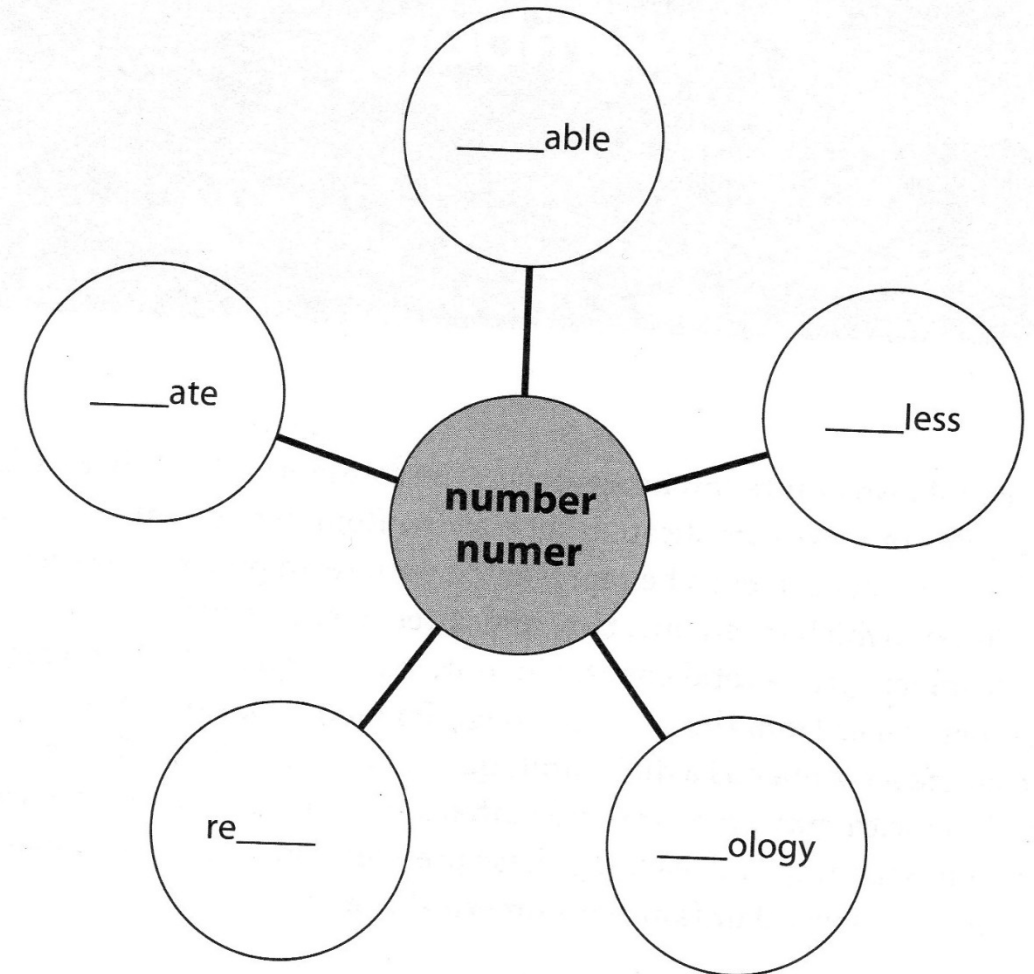
ROOTS

- The base, or original, word. It does not have a prefix or a suffix.
